

Housing for Graduates and Their Guests

Resident graduates are allowed two rooms for the weekend: their own room and one additional room (*both free*). Any additional rooms require a payment of **\$20.00** per person per night. Each room is only permitted to have a maximum of four occupants.

Off- Campus graduates requesting accommodations will receive one free room; additional rooms are **\$20.00** per person per night and are on a first come first served basis. Each room is only permitted to have a maximum of four occupants.

Halcyon Hall Reservation Process

- Graduating Senior must place the reservation request.
- Email must be sent to www.wau.edu/halcyon-hall
- Click on Guest Room Reservation (Fill out the information form)
- **Note:** Only female guests allowed. Male children over the age of 7 are not permitted to stay. Children must be accompanied with parent/guardian at all times.

Morrison Hall Reservation Process

- Graduating Senior must place the reservation request.
- Email must be sent to morrisonhallreservation@gmail.com
- Information Requested: *Graduate's Name, Room Number, Name of Guest, Check In Time*
- Note: Only male guests allowed. Female children over the age of 7 are not permitted to stay. Children must be accompanied with parent/guardian at all times.

All reservation must be made to the Residence Halls by 5:00pm of Monday, April 16, 2018. Reservations will not be accepted verbally or over the phone **NO EXCEPTIONS!!!!**
